WHERE TO FIND ARTWORK

The creative mind has endless possibilities! Just be sure you don't use copyrighted images.

COVER TEMPLATE

Must use a cover template specific to your book size, binding type, number of pages and design program.

SUBMISSION

Pictavo – Scan original artwork and place as an image OR upload a file. Resolution must be 300 DPI or higher at final print size.

Electronic – File types accepted: PSD, JPEG, TIFF, PDF or a packaged InDesign file. This submission option must include the Custom & Specialty Cover Design Form. **Microsoft Word, PowerPoint or Publisher files not accepted.*

UNDERSTANDING A COVER TEMPLATE

FOR CUSTOM COVERS SUBMITTED OUTSIDE OF PICTAVO

COMPONENTS OF A TEMPLATE

BLEED AREA

Items meant to extend all the way to the trim edge (i.e., bleed) should extend into the outermost area of the template called the Bleed Area. Items in the bleed area will be trimmed off during production.

SAFETY MARGIN AREA

Elements not intended to bleed off the cover (e.g., cover title and images) should be placed inside the Safety Margin Area.

WRAP AREA

This area folds over the binders board and will be covered by the endsheet. Keep images and text ¼" from the inside Wrap Area line. If design elements are intended to extend into the wrap area (similar to a bleed) they should extend to the outer Wrap Area line.

CRIMP AREA

This area represents the negative space between the book board and the spine, where the book opens up. Text is not recommended in the crimp area because of distortion during the production process and repeated opening and closing of the cover.

BINDING TYPE: HARD COVER & SMYTH



SPINE AREA Text appearing on the spine should read top to bottom and include a 1/16" margin all around.

BINDING TYPE: **SOFT SADDLE-STAPLED**



BINDING TYPE: SOFT PERFECT BOUND



SPINE AREA A soft perfect bound book contains a spine. Artwork can be placed in this area however, it will be distorted during the manufacturing process. Text and artwork placed in the spine is NOT recommended.

PERSONALIZATION & CUSTOM COVER DESIGNS

OFFERING PERSONALIZATION is a great way for students to enhance their own yearbook. Be sure your cover design accommodates for personalization by checking the placement and design area details below.

FOIL STUDENT NAME & ICON

BINDING STYLES: All

PLACEMENT: Upper right corner or lower right corner; right justified only

ENGRAVED NAMEPLATE

STUDENT NAME: One line, 22-character maximum (including spaces) NAMEPLATE COLOR CHOICES: Gold or silver

PLACEMENT: Nameplates come with a tape strip; student can apply anywhere on cover or inside book

BINDING STYLES: All

NAMEPLATE SIZE: 2.75" wide by 0.75" tall

IMPORTANT COVER INFORMATION

<mark>DEADLINE</mark> February 1 for all cover types.

LATE SUBMISSION

Covers received after February 1 may add two weeks to production time.

PROOFS

A complimentary cover proof is included IF cover is submitted by February 1 (shipping charges will apply). Additional proofs are available — contact your yearbook profivder for pricing and details.

COVER SETUP/CORRECTION FEES

Extensive setup work includes design time beyond scanning and placing artwork into a template. Detailed Photoshop work (modifying artwork/images, creating artwork, layer effects, adjusting color, type effects, fixing bleeds, etc.) will be billed at an hourly rate. Cost estimates available upon request once materials have been submitted.

COVER RESUBMISSION FEE

\$25 per request.

IMAGE RESOLUTION

Images submitted for custom cover printing must be at least 200 dpi unless low resolution printing has been approved on your Custom Cover Form. If you scan your artwork, the resolution must be at least 300 dpi at the final print size. We do not suggest downloading art from the internet without the ability to verify resolution (typically, online images are not print quality).

SOFT COVER PRINTING

INSIDE COVER PRINTING:

Inside front and/or inside back of a soft cover is an extra charge. If you choose to print on either of the interior covers, set up your digital files as described on the previous pages. Also, please indicate if the inside cover is to be printed in color or black and white.

HARD COVER UPGRADES

SPECIALTY TREATMENTS:

Upgrades such as foil, emboss, spot UV, silkscreen and die-cut are available for an additional cost. They require special setup and scheduling. Contact your yearbook provider for more details.

PERSONALIZATION POINTERS

WHAT TO AVOID:

Raised UV treatments on options 3 and 4, or the use of emojis and symbols.

Foil student name (option 3) cannot be stamped on two lines. Options 1 and 2 are not recommended for hard cover or smyth bound books.
